

Acknowledgement of the Intellectual Property Rights Policy under the Statutes of the Standardization Group for Embedded Technologies e.V.

Participation in an SGeT Standards Development Team (SDT) requires all participants to conform to the latest Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) policy, as a supplement to the SGeT statutes and SGeT SDT procedures.

- Any IPR, patent claim or patent application known to a member of an SDT must be disclosed at its earliest possible discovery.
- All IP included in any proposal made by a member remains the property of the member until it is incorporated into a standard adopted by the SGeT
- Any member of the SDT who knows of existing intellectual property rights shall promptly identify them to the SGeT at the time of proposal, but in any case, prior to approval of the standard. SGeT then will immediately request the owner to give within three months an irrevocable undertaking in writing that it is prepared to grant irrevocable licenses to SGeT members on fair, reasonable and nondiscriminatory (“FRAND”) terms and conditions about such IPR.
- The latest IPR rules of SGeT (June 2018) are acknowledged by the declarant
